JOINT STATUS REPORT

Plaintiff Barbara A. Baker (“Plaintiff”) and Defendant 7-Eleven, Inc. (“7-Eleven”), by and through their respective undersigned counsel, submit this Joint Status Report, stating as follows:

1. This matter was filed on September 26, 2024 (Dkt. 1).
2. After the Court denied Defendants motion to dismiss, Defendants filed an Answer on April 20, 2026, denying the allegations of the Complaint and asserting various defenses. (Dkt. 82).
3. The Court then issued an Amended Scheduling Order extending the Parties’ deadlines by 60 days to allow time for settlement discussions. (Dkt. 84).
4. On August 18, 2026, the Parties held a day-long mediation before JAMS mediator Jed D. Melnick, Esq., and have now reached a settlement in principle to resolve this litigation.
5. The Parties will draft the terms of a class action settlement agreement over the next several weeks, and Plaintiff intends to file a motion for preliminary approval of the class action settlement no later than October 5, 2026.

6. Accordingly, the Parties request the Court institute a stay in this matter until the filing of Plaintiff's motion for preliminary approval of the settlement.
